

Dear Parents

Following on from the Government's announcement to re-open Primary Schools, we have been asked to make preparations to open for Nursery, Reception Year 1 and Year 6 pupils. Following meetings with Academy Trust Heads and Health and Safety Representatives, we propose to open on a two week rolling programme where there will be 5 days provision across two weeks e.g. Mon/Wed/Fri and then Tues/Thurs.

Staff will be on a rota to work with specific groups of children, they will be working with Teams A and B. Mixing of staff and pupils will be minimised. Your child's class will be taught by their own class teacher and then swap over to be taught by another teacher. This will ensure every child has the chance to be taught by their own teacher for two weeks out of every 4 week period. Your child will not be guaranteed to be with their own teacher in the first two weeks.

Your child may be taught Mon/Wed/Fri and then Tue/Thur or Tue/Thur and then Mon/Wed/Fri.

Mixing of groups will not be permitted therefore allocated days are non-negotiable.

We will be following stringent Health and Safety guidance and more details will follow next week.

There will be no Breakfast or After School Clubs and Nursery will only run for the morning session. There will be a staggered entrance and collection time for each year group and the children will enter and be collected from an allocated exit for their class. Only 1 parent is permitted to drop off or collect.
