Geography- Find out, record in your own words, pictures about a country that is on the equator/ or either polar region of the world. General information- name, flag, climate, food etc. (Link to Science) What animals live there? How have they adapted to their environment? If time - repeat with a different country in the opposite climate. Compare and contrast.

Art- Investigate patterns in nature. Look at Henri Matisse 'The Snail'. Look at pattern as Camouflage in nature.
