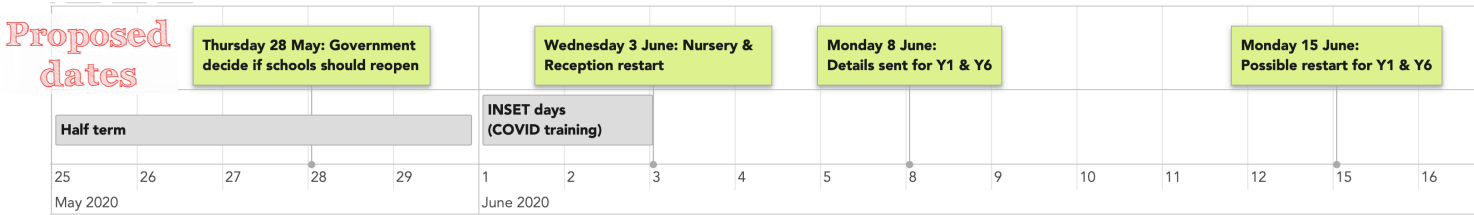


The following guidance will only apply if the government decide to go ahead with the phased reopening of primary schools in England



## Drop-off and pick-up



Your child's specific daily drop off and pick up times will be **emailed** to you ahead of their start date



The school day will be shorter than normal. Please ensure you **arrive punctually** to drop off and pick up each day



Only **one** parent should bring your child to school. Please observe social distancing when queuing and with teaching staff



If possible, please **walk** to school instead of driving. Please do not bring scooters or bikes.

## Come prepared



**Home clothes and trainers** (without laces if possible) should be worn each day. Children should change clothes as soon as they get home and have clean clothes every day



Your child will often be outdoors so please apply **suncream** before school and ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather



Hot lunches will be replaced with **packed lunches** or you can supply your own in a plastic box (no nuts or drinks). Each child will be provided with their own numbered cup for water



If your child needs **medicine** during the school day, place it in the nominated box at drop off. Email the school office about the dosage and give permission for it to be given to your child

## Stay safe



Your child should bring **nothing other than clothing** with them to school - no book bags, stationery, balls, toys, bikes, scooters, or mobile phones



All communication with the office should be by **phone or email only** - not in person



If your child or anyone in your household shows COVID-19 symptoms, **self-isolate and notify the school**



Your child will be washing their hands throughout the day at school. Help us teach the importance of this and how to wash their hands properly
